

Overview: Nicole Reinhart, a 1994 EHS graduate, was a standout athlete in Cross Country and Track as well as a National Marine Corps Youth Physical Fitness Champion. After graduating from high school, Reinhart focused on cycling and won two national élite track championships and two gold medals at the Pan American Games. In 1999, she signed for Saturn Women's Professional Cycling Team. In September 2000, Reinhart lost her life during a 42-mile circuit race held on a 3.5-mile course in Arlington, Massachusetts. The event was the last of four races comprising the 2000 BMC Software Cycling Grand Prix. A \$250,000 prize was awarded to any rider who won all four. Having won the previous three, the organizers donated the prize to Nicole's family, who established the Nicole Reinhart Foundation in her honor. In 2004, Reinhart was inducted posthumously into the Lehigh Valley Velodrome Hall of Fame.

Purpose: The Lehigh Valley Road Runners started the scholarship in the Spring of 2021 as a tribute to Nicole. This scholarship is provided by the proceeds of our annual Emmaus 4 Mile Classic held each April.

Award: A \$4000 scholarship will be awarded annually to the most outstanding Emmaus High School female runner, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee and the LVRR Board of Directors. Applicants may apply to the other LVRR scholarships however winners cannot be awarded more than one scholarship. Eligibility:

- 1. The Nicole Reinhart Memorial Scholarship is limited to Emmaus High School female seniors. This excludes all cyber schools that are not affiliated with East Penn School District.
- 2. All applicants must be eligible to receive a diploma from Emmaus High School and eligible to walk in the Emmaus High School graduation ceremony.
- 3. Must have qualified for and participated in a District XI Cross Country meet.
- 4. Must have qualified in at least one event at the District XI Track and Field meet.
- 5. College-bound female senior.
- 6. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA).

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Finish place number at District XI Cross Country meet will be added to the placing at the District XI Track and Field meet. Lowest sum is the scholarship recipient.
- 2. In the case of a tie, the highest GPA is the recipient.
- 3. If no student meets the criteria listed above, the award will be at the discretion of the LVRR Board of Directors. It is possible that no award will be made that year.

Notification of Award Selection: Applicants will be notified within three weeks from the above date regarding the results of the selection process.
